90 pts “This sees a little merlot and petit verdot (a little over 10% in total). There’s a rich array of blueberries and violets here, together with some darker, stony, slate-like notes. Blackberries and blackcurrants, too. The palate has such intensity and ripe, juicy red, blue and dark-toned fruit flavors. Generous red with plenty of structural depth and weight.”
