BACKGROUND: First released in 1993, this wine was renamed in honor of third gen family member and the winery's champion, Francis "d'Arry" d'Arenberg Osborn (1926-2022), to honor his lifelong service to d'Arenberg and the wine industry. d'Arry's Original delivers its blend of Shiraz and Grenache sourced from d'Arenberg's own low-yielding, 19th century vineyards.

WINEMAKING NOTES: Small batches of grapes are gently crushed and then transferred to open fermenters. Foot treading is undertaken two-thirds of the way through fermentation. The wine is then basket pressed and transferred to oak barriques and large casks to complete primary and secondary fermentation and is aged on lees to keep the wine fresh. There is no racking until final blending, and no fining or filtration prior to bottling.

TASTING NOTES: Amazing ruby color. Quite floral on the nose with a fusion of black and red fruits, and notes of fresh red cranberries. Hints of pomegranate and rhubarb make for a nice profile in the silky mouth-coating. Find a little hint of green tomato leaf and dragon fruit among fine and round tannins. Very well balanced, with a lifted vibrancy. Amazing length and a fresh finish. Classic d'Arenberg.

ABOUT d'ARENBERG: One of the undisputed kings of Australian Shiraz and Rhone varietals, d'Arenberg elevates individuality into an art form.
