QUALITY, INTEGRITY, SUSTAINABILITY: The Wilyabrup Cullen Vineyard is carbon neutral, biodynamically farmed and dry-grown with certification from Australian Organic Limited, as are the winery operations. The vines are planted on their own roots and are low yielding, harvest on mainly Fruit and one Flower Day, and provided some skin contact to give phenolic tension. A portion was fermented in concrete egg.

VINTAGE NOTES: As usual, this blend contains a greater volume of Sauvignon Blanc than Semillon, which reflects the outstanding qualities of the fruit produced by the former variety on the Cullen Vineyard. The 2022 vintage grew wines of immense perfume and texture. The cooler season and low yields ensured the health of the vines and hence the fruit quality: exceptionally good for Sauvignon Blanc, and of course Cabernet Sauvignon.

TASTING NOTES: In the glass, light straw with green tinges, providing aromas of feijoa (pineapple guava), apple, lime and citrus, and limestone. Breaks with a bright, fresh, crisp acidity, driving the mineral palate, expressing great length, texture and polish. This wine still has a while to go to fully express itself. On the finish the delicious crunch is inviting you to have another taste! Drink now - 2040.

She's won numerous awards, including Halliday Wine Companion's "Viticulturist of the Year" 2022, and was awarded the Order of Australia by King Charles III for her service to viticulture and oenology in 2023.
