

2019 d'ARENBERG THE LOVE GRASS SHIRAZ

Review Summary



95 pts "Love grass is another weed that attaches itself to the workers' socks – and this Shiraz will 'linger with you in the same way that the flowers do'. Gentle crushing, open fermenters, foot treading, basket-pressing and then aging in French oak for up to 18 months. Sourced from Organic-certified vineyards.

The color is black/purple. Wonderful aromas here, with blackcurrants, leather, chocolate, plums, cloves, some florals, which are ever-so-appealing. There is impressive length here and the intensity is maintained throughout. Very fine tannins, good balance, some early complexity. Great stuff. And a serious contender for the best value wine of the year."
