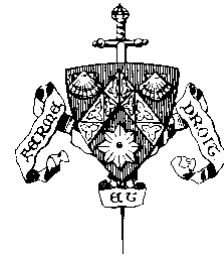


2019 YERINGBERG SHIRAZ

95 pts “A lot of complexity and savoriness come out to play this vintage, alongside a wonderful coolness across the palate. Expect dark plums, licorice and menthol, juniper, a dash of pepper and roasted root vegetables. It’s fuller-bodied, with a covering of textural tannins and bright acidity.”
