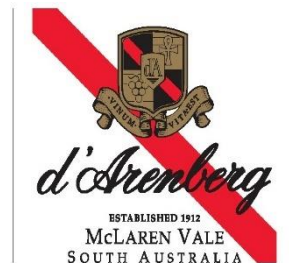


**2019 d'ARENBERG

Review Summary



92 pts “This robust red shows a good mix of plum, cherry and toasted herb flavors, plus notes of lingonberry preserves. Firm and dense tannins add an appealing chewiness to the profile. Details of tobacco, dark chocolate and black licorice linger on the finish. Drink now through 2031. 100 cases imported.”

92 pts “An inviting nose of baked cherry, blueberry, moss and bark. Medium- to full-bodied with velvety tannins. Juicy and fresh red and black fruit with savory undertones. Herb and earthy notes ground the palate. A bit of tension here, which I like. Drink or hold. Screw cap.”

90 pts “Though the wine is starting to show a little bottle age, there's still plenty of varietal fruit in the form of cherry and strawberry cordial, with some toasted coconut, spice and violet notes below. Tannins are still prominent and texturally interesting, chiseled and raspy. The juicy fruit is still at the fore. Drink now–2026.”
