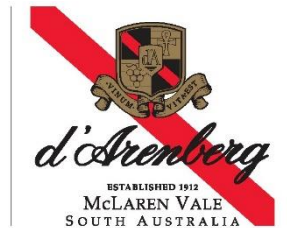


2019 d'ARENBERG THE COPPERMINE ROAD

91 pts “A full-bodied wine of ample sweet berry fruit, some dried garden herbs and the house signature of mocha oak. The tannins are less than refined. While further cellaring might help this along, I'd be inclined to drink up. Drink or hold. Screw cap.”

90 pts “This is usually a powerful expression with bags of fruit boxed in by oak and extractive tannins, and this is no exception. The style is purposeful, with a consistent lineage. It is not for everyone, however. But nor does it need to be. It's full of fruit – with a hedge of varietal herbal notes – but there's nothing sweet-fruited about it, being dry-toned, structured and mouth-puckering. It is, no doubt, intended to age for many years, and with that, may come more charm. The score, a reflection of the moment rather than a prediction.”
