



2022 JOHN DUVAL WINES ANNEXUS MATARO

Review Summary



93+ pts “The 2022 Annexus Mataro leads with a pop; it has a bright nose of strawberry and cherry, raspberry, cocoa and licorice. It is on the palate where the emergence of complexity from the 100-year-old vines becomes evident. This is texturally complex and chewy, and it provides a full 360-degree view of Mataro: tannin, earth, fruit, spice, length and finesse. Perhaps it's slightly less elegant but slightly more immediately pleasurable and seductive? Lovely wine nonetheless. Really good. 14.5% alcohol, sealed under screw cap.”
