



# 2021 JOHN DUVAL WINES COMONO CABERNET SAUVIGNON

## Review Summary



**94 pts** “A distinctive red, offering an aromatic mix of amaretto, morello cherries in syrup, framboise and red licorice accented by notes of caraway, cumin and tobacco. The tannins are plump and juicy before firming on the finish, where a hint of gravelly earth lingers. Drink now through 2035.”

**93 pts** “The 2021 Comono Cabernet marks the first release of this cuvee. The fruit is from the Angas family's Hutton Vale farm up in Eden Valley, with 10% of the fruit from high Moppa (380 meters elevation). Aromatically, the fruit is leafy and spiced, with blackberry and raspberry nuance, rose petals and tobacco. The detail in fruit and tannin here is impressive, and the wine is balanced and fresh. The tannins are a highlight through the mineral finish. 14% alcohol, sealed under screw cap.”
