Review Summary

92 pts "This delivers a lot for a meager tariff. Air is required, but once liberated, the wine coheres into a crisp image of fragrantly lifted but ripe cabernet – blackcurrant pastille, currants, cedar, mulberry, raspberry leaf with graphite and an iodine-laced maritime feel. Tannins are agreeably fine, with flavors carrying long. It's a fine example, and further proof of how well the variety can perform in the region."
