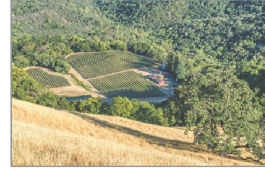


# 2022 ROBERT CRAIG WINERY MOUNT VEEDER CABERNET SAUVIGNON



**WINEMAKER:** Jason Price  
**REGION:** Napa Valley, California  
**VARIETALS:** Cabernet Sauvignon (91%), Cabernet Franc (7%), Malbec (1%), Petit Verdot (1%)  
**MATURATION:** 18 months in 70% new French oak  
**ANALYSIS:** 14.5% alc/vol | TA: 6.4 g/L | pH: 3.70

**VINTAGE:** Cane-pruned, organically farmed. Starting in 2019, Robert Craig enlisted Phil Coturri and Enterprise Vineyard Management to prune the vines back slowly, making small cuts and leaving ample room around the trunks so as not to impede sap flow or cause desiccation zones in the vines. The result meant going from 22 tons of yield to 9 tons over the next four vintages with the goal of improved quality. 2022 was a low-yield vintage for the Amentet Vineyard; the balanced vines at 1700' have produced a Cabernet that is traditional in the best way.

**TERROIR:** Perched at 1,700' of elevation along Wall Road on the north end of the Mount Veeder AVA, this 6.5-acre vineyard is destined for greatness. The sandy, gravel-based soils of shale with a sandstone topsoil produce wines that are black in color with very low PH values and naturally high acids. A perfect combination for longevity. The beauty of this warmer, fog-free northern section of Mount Veeder is that the wines are free of any unwanted vegetal or rustic characteristics that can affect cooler climate sites to the south.

**TASTING NOTES:** This wine is black and untamed with a direct sense of the chalky, white fossilized marine material that surged up off of the ocean floor five million years ago. Look for dark floral tones, graphite, conifer forest floor and explosive dark cassis fruit in its core. The wine is such a child of Mount Veeder that it's hard to miss in a blind tasting.

**ABOUT ROBERT CRAIG WINERY:** With a passion for Napa Valley Mountain Cabernet, Bob Craig founded his eponymous winery on Howell Mountain with three friends from business school. In 2004, CEO Elton Slone joined the winery and became a full partner in 2007. Following Bob's retirement and departure from the wine business in 2012, Slone has continued to move the business forward with the other three founding partners. Known for producing small-lot, site-expressive wines from high elevation vineyards, Robert Craig Winery consistently garners high scores and positive accolades from the wine press.
