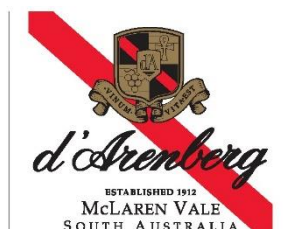


2020 d'ARENBERG THE COPPERMINE ROAD

94 pts “Bold aromas of blackcurrants, blackberry compote, blueberries, violets and cedar. The palate is full-bodied with firmly framed tannins and balanced acidity, giving flavors of eucalyptus, iodine and tobacco leaves. Bold, with a stylistic touch. Drink or hold. Screw cap.”

There’s lots going on here. This is a compacted, dense wine. Clove and dried mint tannin linger on the finish. 14.5% alcohol, sealed under screw cap.”
